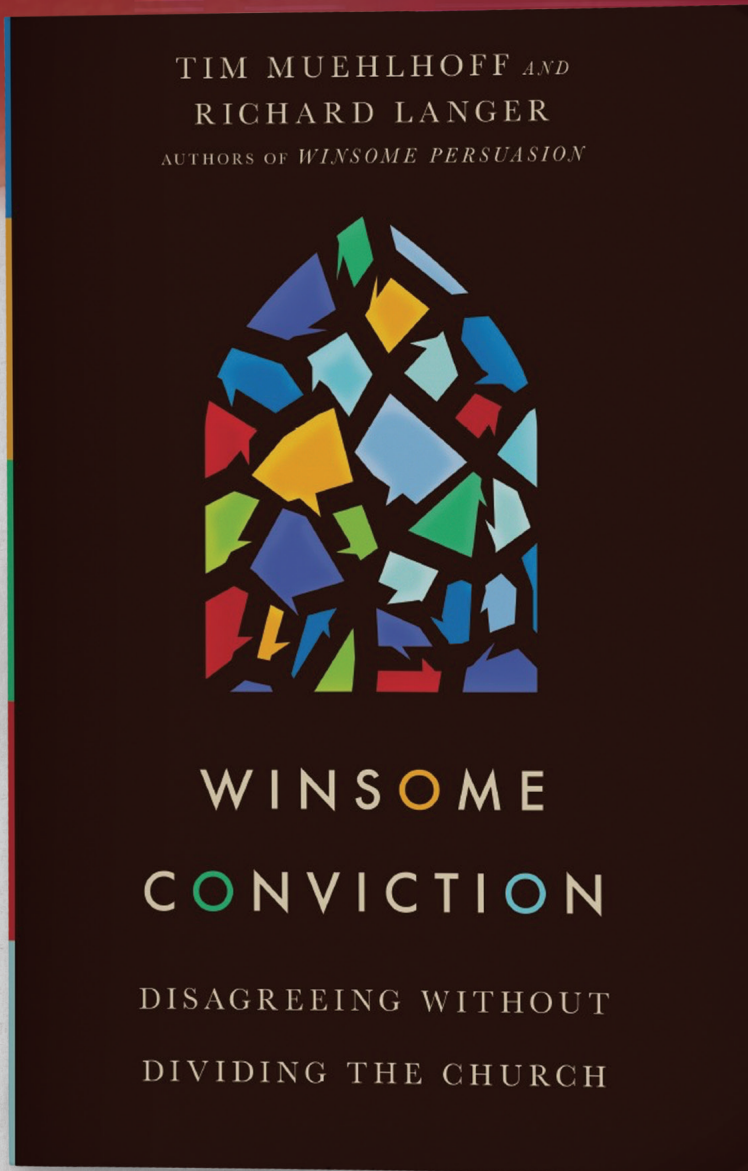


The greatest threat to the Church today is division.
